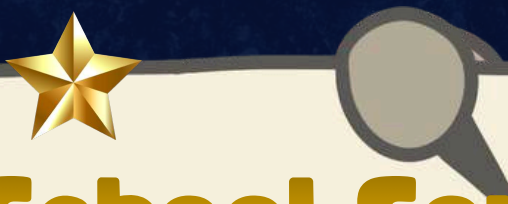

MESSAGES FROM TEACHERS

6A Class Teacher Miss Mak

Dear students of Class 6A,

As we are approaching graduation once again, I find myself standing at the edge of something both beautiful and bittersweet. This year is special—not only because it marks your graduation, but because it also brings me back to many memories of how you grew, learned, and became yourselves.

Class 6A is made up of 23 students. Half of you were my students since Primary 1. Back then, you were full of curiosity, still learning how to cooperate, organize your belongings, and find your place in the classroom. Later, as you moved to Primary 2, I continued to teach you. Then in Primary 5, I took the English class again. This time, the journey is almost complete. You are now in Primary 6, and soon you will step into a new chapter. As your Class Teacher, I have mixed feelings—happiness for your progress, pride in your growth, and an even deeper sense of reluctance to let you go.

Let me start with the slogan we wrote at the beginning of the school year:

“Be the role model to other classes.”

We did not just write it on paper—we truly lived it. Each of you is different. Some students are gentle; some are confident. Some learn quickly; some need more time. Some speak up easily; some are quieter. But what I admire most is that you did not try to “be the same.” Instead, you accepted different opinions and different personalities, and you created a classroom where harmony and care coexist naturally.

Whenever we had a dictation, you would remind each other in your own friendly way: “Let’s see who is first in the dictation.” Before the exam, you would say: “Dear classmates! Good luck! Hope we all fulfill Ms. Mak’s wish and get high marks!!!” After the exam: “Well done 6A! We all did our best.” That small moment made me feel proud and relaxed. It was not just about winning—it was about supporting each other, encouraging each other, and enjoying learning together.

In every lesson, you always had many questions. Sometimes the questions were simple; sometimes they were unexpected and creative. You would raise your hand and ask again—almost as if you were determined to truly understand, not just to “get through.” Because of this, I never dared to be careless or stop thinking as a teacher. You made learning alive.

And because you are so eager to learn, I tried my best to keep lessons engaging. I used students’ real-life examples, connected ideas to quizzes and practice activities, and even adjusted the teaching pace depending on what you needed. I could see it clearly: you smiled while working. You were not only completing tasks—you were thinking, discovering, and remembering. When you could recall the key teaching points correctly, I knew you had succeeded—not by luck, but by effort. One of the greatest things I witnessed was your learning spirit. You always wanted to be the best. In dictation, you aimed for the first place. In writing, someone achieved first place—and the next time, it was another student. That is not only improvement—it is teamwork and motivation. The learning atmosphere in Class 6A was truly excellent.

Seeing the World with Heart

During the year, we also went on meaningful activities. One memorable experience was our visit to the Hong Kong Society for the Blind. After that visit, the way you shared your experience on stage made me realize something clearly:

You have truly grown up.

You did not only speak as students—you organized yourselves. You arranged the drama performance, designed small games, and invited students from the audience to interact with you. Watching you take charge made me feel as if you were already “independent”—like little teachers. You understood that communication is not just about speaking; it is also about empathy, respect, and sharing meaningful learning with others.

Strong Body, Strong Character

At the sports field, I saw another side of you. When you played football, you fought for every shot and never easily gave up. You pushed yourself to try again after mistakes. Some moments are things I usually do not see in daily classroom life, but in that field, I saw your determination clearly.

Can be scholarly, and also can be strong—this is who you are.

You showed that effort and courage can exist in every part of life.

Graduation Trip: Ocean Park (and Excitement Before Departure)

I also wanted to share our graduation trip to Ocean Park. However, at the time this issue goes to print, we haven’t set off yet because the magazine deadline is before the trip. Still, even before departure, you’re excited. That excitement tells me something important: you are close as a class, and you look forward to making more memories together.

And you made a promise with me—you plan to ride the thrilling rides together with me. (I heard you loud and clear.) I’m ready. I’m sure this trip will become another beautiful memory you’ll carry with you.

Finally, to Class 6A, I want to say thank you. They often say, “You are my favorite teacher. You are the best teacher.” Even if it may not be perfectly true, I choose to believe it, because it represents how you feel about me. Thank you for your encouragement and for cheering me on all the way.

Thank you for being responsible, thoughtful, and full of energy. Thank you for the effort you put into learning and the care you showed to one another. Most of all, thank you for allowing me to be your class teacher for these years.

After you graduate, please remember this: you are always welcome to come back and visit me.

Please keep in touch, keep shining, and keep growing—both in knowledge and character.

Wishing you a bright future, and hoping we will meet again soon.

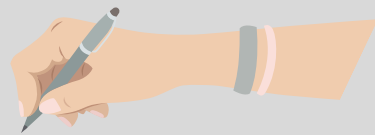
